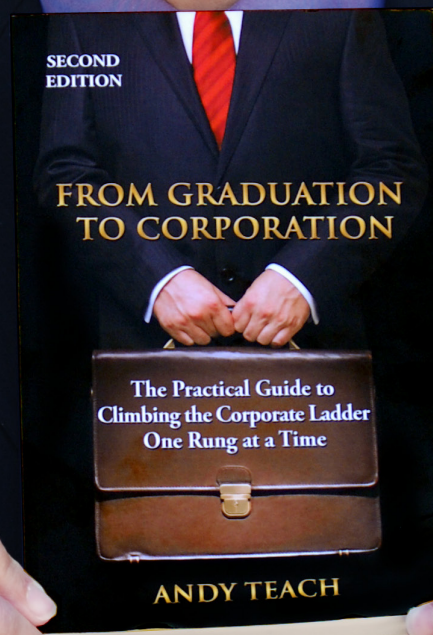

EXPERIENCE

A thirty-year corporate veteran, Andy Teach received seven promotions during his career and was most recently Vice President, Network & Cable Research at a major Hollywood studio until he became an author and speaker.

Andy was an unlikely corporate soldier when he graduated from college, embarking on a three-week, 1300-mile bicycle journey from New Jersey to Florida instead of joining the work world. After his trip, he landed a position as an assistant media planner for a top ten advertising agency in New York City. He was promoted to media planner within six months, then joined another New York ad agency as an assistant account executive. This agency specialized in motion picture advertising, which helped Andy later realize that his true calling was in the entertainment industry.

Andy later moved to Los Angeles, where he worked as a TV production assistant before getting his big break at a major entertainment company, where he worked for 23 years, rising from the bottom rung as a research clerk to the position of vice president.
